

Medical Certificate for Employment Insurance Sickness Benefits

An individual must get a medical certificate signed by a medical practitioner when they apply for Employment Insurance (EI) sickness benefits.

The medical practitioner completes and signs **Section 2** to attest that the patient is unable to work for medical reasons.
